Applicants:

- Carbon County high school senior graduates
- Successfully accepted and enrolled in college or trade school for fall semester. (You may apply before you are accepted and enrolled, however, proof of enrollment will be required for scholarship funds will be awarded.)
- Application opens August 17, 2026, and the deadline to submit is April 1, 2027.

Scholarship

- (4) \$500 scholarships awarded
- Scholarship funds are awarded for the academic year in which the student is selected. Upon verification of enrollment, the award will be issued directly to the college, university, or trade school the recipient is attending and applied to the student's account.

To be considered the following are required:

1. Complete the application and include a cover letter, 2 letters of recommendation, and resume highlighting your achievements. Please attach a photo of yourself that will be used for congratulatory marketing.
2. Create short video (recommended 3 minutes, up to 5 minutes max) responding to the question of your choice below:
 - a. If you could implement one thing to benefit the youth in your community and money wasn't an issue, what would you do?
 - or
 - b. If you were to come back to your community after graduating college, what would you do to improve the community?
3. Then, have a little fun with it and tell us who your favorite superhero is and why?
4. To submit your application, first email the Scholarship Committee at scholarships@bocrawlins.com and request a SECURE LINK. We will respond with a link for you to upload supporting documents. Typically, video files are too large for us to receive via email, so it is important to request the link before sending in your application and video or we may not receive your information.
